

Jagannath Panda – The Action of Nowhere

Jagannath Panda, born in 1970 and now New Delhi -based, whose works were also showcased at the exhibition "Chalo! India" took place in Tokyo and Seoul , will have the second solo exhibition at Nature Morte in New Delhi. The gallery indicates that what his works represent matches with the gallery's most fundamental doctrines: Nature/Culture, Urban/Rural, Tradition/Contemporary and Figuration/Abstraction. Jagannath Panda describes animals oddly set in urban situation, and the contrast seems to alert the unbalanced society.
